Hate-Motivated Incidents in Orange County






Hello OC Human Relations,

I'm reaching out to you on behalf of a Japanese National (NHK BS) TV Documentary Program that is interested in reporting on the current state of hate crimes in Southern California. We are developing a 60-minute in depth look at the situation for national broadcast in Japan.

We realize that with the mass demonstrations regarding racial discrimination and violence that have been occurring since last year, the media has a tendency to focus on the negative. It is our intent to show the other side; to show people that they have allies who are fighting every day on their behalf to stop hate crimes and racially-motivated violence. We hope that through this program, more people can come to understand the extent to which people and organizations such as yours are working every day to protect them and their way of life. We'd very much like to show how there are folks like yourself who are hard at work actively combating the situation.

- 4) Access to existing footage of past activities related to the topic.

We are hoping to shoot the entirety of the program between late August and late November.
