ACTION ITEMS

4. Chief Mike Hamel invited Commissioners to the reconvening of the Solidarity March and Summit on Tuesday October 18th. It is a follow-up from the August event to continue the conversation about ways to improve police-community relations in the county. Commissioner Inouye requested that there be specific outreach to the Latino Community and that Supervisor Do be invited to speak.

5.
