
 Commission Director presented 2018 Hate Crime report data for OC Human Relations Council event reaching up to 150 people.


• 12% increase in hate crimes from 2017

Hate activity increased in 2018 for O.C.


• 37% increase in hate incidents from last year

Steady rise in hate activity in the last 5 years


10 YEAR TREND FOR HATE CRIMES & HATE INCIDENTS IN O.C.




2018 Hate Crime vs. Hate Incident - Motivations
